some music in the different styles?  
How do they differ? (consider  
tempo, volume, pitch and beat)  
Which instruments can you hear?

Choose a musician. Listen to some  
of their music. What genre is it?  
Find out about the musician and  
write a fact file about them.

#### Lean on Me:

Listen to 'Lean on Me', a  
soul/gospel song by Bill Withers.  
(links on Seesaw)  
What instruments can you hear?  
Can you clap a rhythm? Learn to  
sing the lyrics and perform the song.

Perhaps research this famous artist  
in more detail.

family is it in? How does it work?

Write about your instrument or  
create an advert for when the  
instrument goes on sale.
