Writing

*Imagine your dream house. **What rooms would you like to have in your house? Can you write a description of your dream house?**

Reading

*Read a story aloud to someone. **Can you use voices to represent each character?**

***Read and Compare:** What do 'The Three Little Pigs' and 'Hansel and Gretel' have in common? Read both of the stories and compare them.

Maths- Number Facts and Place Value

*Look for the numbers on the doors of houses. **Do the numbers get bigger or smaller as you go up and down the street? What patterns do you notice?**

*Create your own 1-100 square (using the grid below). **What patterns can you colour in?**

*Odd and Even Numbers Investigation Choose 10 numbers between 0 and 30. Count out/ draw that number of objects and share them into 2 groups. **Which can you share? Which can you not? What do you notice?**
