Daily Expectations

- Spend **15 minutes** reading- books, comics, magazines- any reading is great!
- Spend **15 minutes** doing some maths on **Numbots, Sumdog or My Maths**
- Practise reading and writing these words:

 - **love**

Write each one in a sentence. Can you use more than one?

Writing

- *Draw and label your face. **What can you see?**
- * Write a list of the things that you can see in your garden
- *Keep a diary of what you see outside your window each day. Write in sentences
- ***Hide and Seek:** Write a set of instructions on how to find something in your bedroom. Think about the positional language to help find the object.

Reading

- *Listen to a book read aloud.
- *Read a non-fiction book **What can you find out?**
- *Study a magazine or newspaper article. **Can you find any words that you know?** Make a list of the words you find, using your word bag to help
- *Which character is worse? Goldilocks or Jack? Read the stories 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and decide. **Can you explain why? Can you persuade someone else?**

Maths- Measuring

- *Make a timetable for your day. **What do you do first? What is the last activity you do each day?**
- ***Sorting:** Sort your toys into groups. You could make a tally chart while you sort them. **How are they similar and different? Could you display your results in a graph?**
- ***Who in your house has the biggest feet? How can you find out?**
