

Languages at Hainford

Hainford uses and builds upon the National Curriculum and our own knowledge and skills progression documents to ensure that children develop their skills, knowledge and understanding in languages.

In class one, once fully settled into life at school children are introduced to the idea of different languages through greetings from around the world.

In both class two and three, French is the language of study. Year 2 children learn to enjoy languages and are expected to develop their listening and speaking skills. Year 3s are expected to hold simple conversations and begin to record their understanding in single words or simple phrases. Some of this is recorded on SeeSaw (a programme that enables parents to access videos of their children).

In class three, children build on their language knowledge and skills from class two and build up to phrases, sentences and more extended conversations. Some of which are recorded on SeeSaw.
