Whilst at Frettenham, children are taught about their rights and responsibilities in order to develop the courage to ask questions and be critical of what they see and hear, to identify and manage risks and make decisions for themselves. Courage is needed in order for children to build resilience when faced with challenging changes but also when developing the skills and strategies to create change themselves as they grow older.

Creativity is fostered as children learn about goal setting and presentation skills at school as well as when considering career, enterprise skills and aspirations for the future.
