#### **Phonics**

Reception will continue to recap Phase 3 in phonics and how they use this in their writing. We will be looking at writing sentences independently and reading them out. This will also support their blending skills to be used in their reading.

Year 1 will be continuing to explore alternative spelling rules and reading/spelling high frequency words to be used confidently in their writing.

This will support their development in independent reading and comprehension skills.

### R.E and Values

Class 1 will be looking different churches around Norfolk and will be going on a VIRTUAL Tour of Norwich Cathedral to look and compare this with our own Hainford Church.

## <u>Science</u>

Class 1 will be looking at Materials this half term and using their knowledge of different water resistance to design a picnic blanket ready for the summer weather. Alongside this Class 1 will be looking at the features of a summer season and how it impacts different animals which will also be linked to their Turtles Inquiry.

#### Literacy

As a class we will be looking at a variety of books; 'Rapunzel' by Beth Woolvin, 'Tusk Tusk' by David McKee and 'I want my Hat Back'. Alongside non ficton texts linked to our Inquiry of 'Turtles by The Sea'. Year 1 will be looking at different writing techniques and developing their confidence.

Reception will be completing writing challenges linked to our focus texts and working on their independent writing.



## Maths

Year 1 will be tackling maths problems linked to Time and Money, alongside this they will be revisiting partitioning into tens and ones and developing their reasoning skills in Maths.

Reception will be looking at developing their addition and subtraction within 20, counting to 100, consolidating their number bonds to 10, and how to use a number line and a 10's frame in Maths.

#### Reading

In Class 1 we will be continuing to focus on developing the reading skills of all children. For Year 1 we will also be focusing on their comprehension skills- these are the skills to lift information from a fiction or non-fiction texts. Reception will be introduced to answering verbal questions about the books we are reading to assess their understanding of the books.

It is still really important that the children are being read with at home daily to secure their confidence in reading.

## <u>PSHE</u>

We will be covering topics the following topics in PSHE:

Different Families and Communities, Diversity, Our Mental Health, Our Privacy, Different types of Secrets and Surprises.

# Geography

Class 1 will be looking at a variety of beaches and seaside towns around the UK. They will be exploring different traditions and games from the Victorian Era to Modern Day

## DT

Class 1 will be exploring the different ways to use clay to make 3D images and experimenting with different ways to manipulate clay.
