<u>Class 1 Home Learning – Environment</u> <u>WC</u>

Daily Expectations

- Spend 15 minutes reading- books, comics, magazines- any reading is great!
- Spend 15 minutes doing some maths, counting backwards from 10, 20 or 100 or play on Numbots.
- Practise reading and writing words from the high 100 frequency word list (6 per day).
 → Write each one in a sentence. Can you use more than one?
- Spend 15 minutes playing a phonics game on Phonics Play or Top Marks.
- Year 1 Spend 15 minutes on spelling shed.

Writing

*Write a thank you letter to the people who collect your rubbish and recycling. What could you include in your letter?

*Can draw and label the plants in your garden and or in the house?

*Go on a litter pick around your front and back garden. Create a poster to remind people to put rubbish in the bin.

*Practise writing your first, last and middle names!

Reading

*Listen to a story read aloud (Miss Riches on Tapestry on Monday, Wednesday and Friday).

*Find, read and highlight words from the 100 high frequency word list in a newspaper or a magazine.

*Listen to **Newsround** and discuss what has been happening in the world this week. What new things have you found out?

*Read a book, or listen to a BBC clip about how to look after the environment.

Maths- Numbers

*Practise counting on a 100 square, you could use SPLAT <u>https://www.primarygames.co.uk/pg2/splat/splatsq100.html</u>

*Write out numbers to 20, or 100 (Year 1s) and then practise writing numbers to 10 in words.

*Create 5 addition and 5 subtraction number sentences for a friend to solve. Can a grown up make some for you to solve?

*Challenge: Complete a 'measures' game on https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/5-7-years/measures

Environment



*<u>Weather Reporter</u>: pick a day that you would like to present as a weather reporter. **Can you create some symbols to use when you are talking about the weather? Can you record the weather everyday?**

*<u>Switch it off</u>: Look at all the electrical devices you have in your house. Are they all plugged in and turned on? Do they need to be? Create a poster to place around the house to remind people to switch it off once they have finished.

*<u>Recycling/Exploring Materials:</u> Give your child a selection of packaging to sort into groups to recycle. **Can you name the material it's made from?** Plastic, paper, metal, card?

Enrichment Activities



Build a den inside or outside your home. Can you work together as a family?

Make something you've never made before, a dessert or a drink. Can you write a list of the ingredients you used? Can you write a recipe?
