- Target = Shoe, Bucket

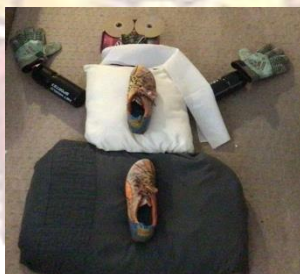
Do you want to build a snowman?

T	25 Star Jumps
U	15 sit ups
V	Jog on the spot for 30 seconds
W	Dance to your favourite Christmas song
X	Jump up and down 5 times like Santa going down the chimney
Y	Mountain Climbers for 30 seconds
Z	Curl up into a snowball for 20 seconds
