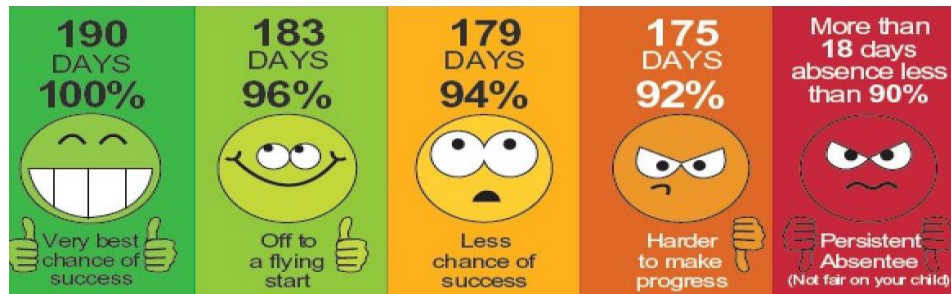
**Improvement works:**
