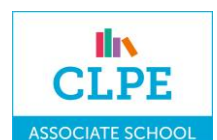
Hainford Newsletter

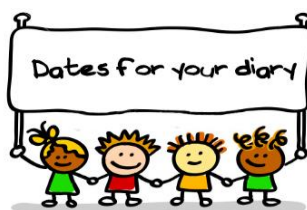
