Thank you to the Hainford PTA who have supported the school in securing access to all maths games on this website. There are games suitable for all children that can be accessed on a wide range of devices.

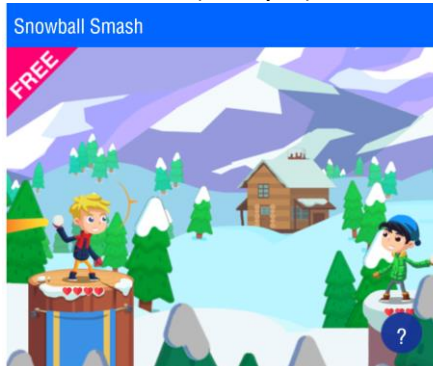

Jubilee Day

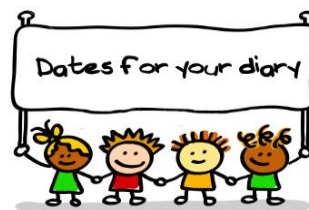
