If you have any wise sayings that you use then please share these with your children so they can bring to school for each class's display.

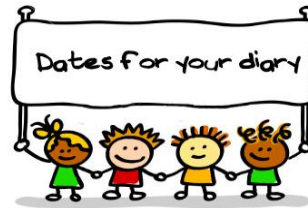
