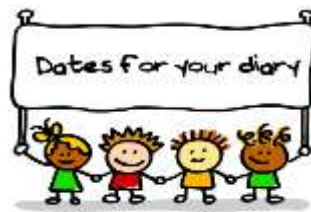
### **Celebration Afternoon**
