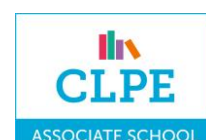


Harvest Festival 2025

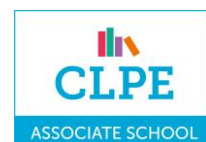


Sporting Opportunities

Our Christian Theme for this half-term is Thankfulness.

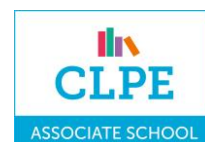
A Christian Perspective on Thankfulness:

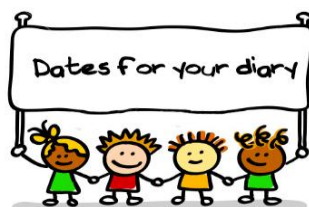
