Keeping Safe

Whilst we have returned to a full curriculum and more normalised school routines, we are still acutely aware that Covid is still, and is likely to be, a factor in school life and beyond for the foreseeable future. The main strategies that we are using at Hainford and across Nebula schools are: maximising fresh air; respecting personal space; advocating regular and thorough personal hygiene and additional cleaning protocols. When indoors, classes will not mix as much and children will remain more within their class groups.

As parents / carers we ask that you respect personal space when on the school site and of course seek a PCR test if your child develops Covid symptoms. Children should continue to wash their hands once they return home from school.
