

## Writing

To maintain the quality of your child's writing we would recommend doing at least one piece of writing a week. You can write about whatever you like! Below are a set of suggestions.

### All:

- Write a diary about your time at home
- a fact file about your favourite animal
- a recipe for something that you have made / cooked
- A creative adventure story
- An information page about Easter or spring
