Hainford uses and builds upon the National Curriculum. Geography is carefully integrated into our rolling programmes. The development of Knowledge and skills specific to Geography are rigorously planned through Reception to Year 6 so that children grow their knowledge and skills.

We regularly use inquiries to deepen children's understanding, especially in regard to the impact on people and communities.

Children in each year have the opportunity to study three in-depth studies each year. These provide a balanced and broad programme ensuring that children develop their map skills, field-work skills and deepen their geographical knowledge.

We believe that it is vital that children apply their skills in the outside environment, using their ever developing fieldwork skills to study the physical and human worlds around them.

Throughout their time at Hainford, their education is further enriched through opportunities such as: recycling projects, Hedgehog charity fund-raising and litter picks.

When significant national or international events take place, children will also have the opportunity to spend time exploring the related issues.
