Wednesday 18th December at 5.30pm

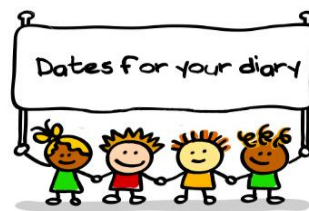
