Bubbles

Children have been allocated into bubbles (groups of children) which will be kept separate during the school day. Bubble A consists of class 1 while Bubble B consists of classes 2 and 3.

Each bubble will have access to their own playground and field space and will not mix at all during the school day.

Drop-off and Collection

We are required to stagger the school day at the start and end of the day to ensure that we do not create a gathering of parents/children. We will use a very simple system which we require you to adhere to. We require you to attend at the time we have stated.

Please at all times keep to the social distancing requirements. Separate drop-off and collection times for each bubble are:

Bubble A (Class 1): Drop-off 8:45 to 8:50 & collection 3pm

Bubble B (Classes 2&3): Drop-off 8:35 to 8:45 & collection 2:50 to 3pm

Communication

Due to the strict collection and drop off times coupled with the quantity of children to be entering and leaving the School, it will not be possible for the teachers to have their usual Hainford morning chats! We would ask that should you need to contact your child's teacher, you let the office know or use Tapestry/Seesaw. A simple email to the school office (office@hainford.norfolk.sch.uk) to update us on information we need to know for that day, would be welcomed. We can quickly organise video calls or telephone calls to discuss any concerns, queries or praise should the need arise.

School items

No school bags to be brought to school.

Children are only to bring a water bottle and lunchbox and coat/sunhat. All pen/pencils, books etc will be provided. We will allow school books to go back and forth between home and school, but once your child has finished with the book we will store this book for 72 hours before returning it to our library.
