**Staffing**

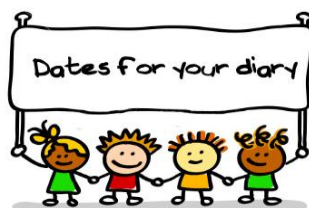
