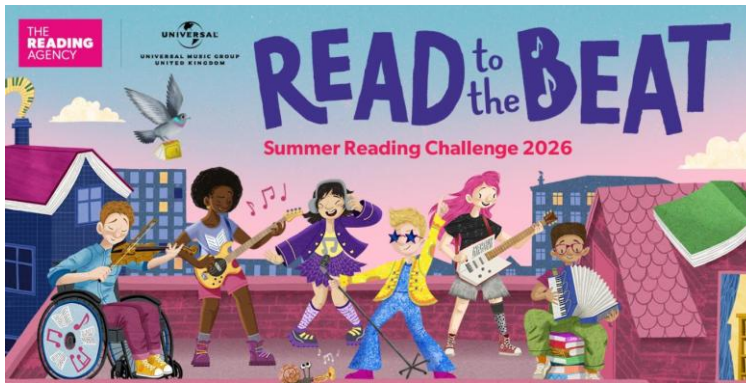
End of year reports

On Thursday 9th July 3pm

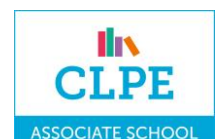

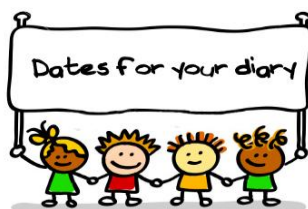
