## Hainford Newsletter

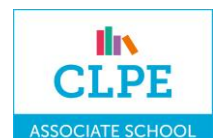

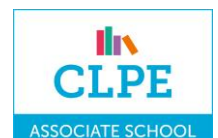

Class 3	<b>Poppy M</b> - for inspired poetry writing	<b>Mackenzie</b> – for being a real friend on class 3's trip

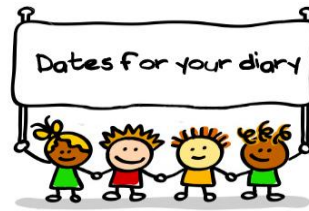
