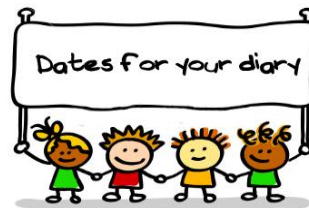


Parent Cafe
