As a school community, we will explore how all members of the school community can serve one another. We will continue to encourage pupils to be empathetic and sympathetic to the experience of others.

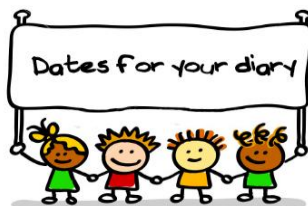
