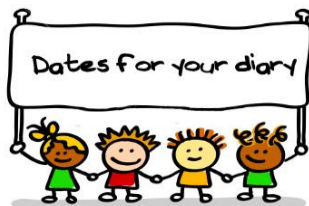
As a school community, we will be exploring how we can all serve one another and show gratitude to those who serve us.
