The Britcher compassion award – Gary for displaying a compassionate attitude towards his classmates and always looking out for them.

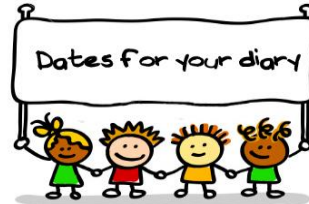
