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
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

How does it work? From Monday 14th November to Wednesday 16th November, students can compete against others across England in answering as many multiplication and division questions correctly as they can. The winning school and class will be based on the highest average number of correct answers per student.

- 1. Every correct answer that a student gives, in any game type, between the hours of 07:30 GMT to 19:30 GMT each day within the competition period will contribute to their class and school score.
- 2. There is a 60-minute limit playtime per player, per day. Those 60-minutes do not need to be played in one block they can be spread throughout each day.





This year, Children in Need has launched 'The Great Spotacular' to celebrate all things spotty. Here are the events we will be taking part in on **Friday 18**<sup>th</sup> **November**:

- For a donation of 50p you can come into school **dressed in a spotty outfit**. This could be a spotty animal, Pudsey or Blush, face paint or spotty clothes.
