Our Christian Theme for this half-term is Responsibility.

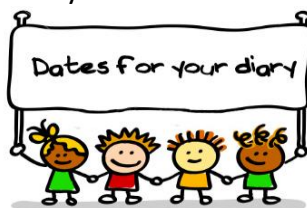
A Christian Perspective on Responsibility:
