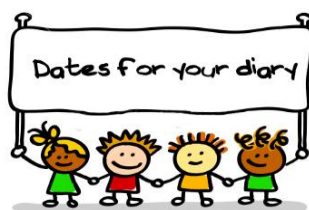
## Schools and Communities Team
